AutoCAD Free Download usage is affected by its market share, with the introduction of an update to a major release being released as a Beta update or Public Beta (sometimes referred to as a Developer Beta). AutoCAD is listed as a beta product on the developer web site. In version 2013, the software does not support the Windows 8 operating system, requires an Intel x64-based computer with a Core i5 or later processor (except for the very first version, 1982, which ran on an Altair 8800), and includes a 64-bit versions of both Autodesk DWG and DWF. AutoCAD is primarily used to create 2D drawings. The 2D drawing toolset is similar to that of Adobe Illustrator, and contains vector-based shapes, basic artistic features, and a simple rasterizing/painting toolset. An integrated DWG viewer (both 2D and 3D) is available, but is only for previewing and not for use in creating 2D drawings. AutoCAD is also available in a variety of different interfaces: Desktop apps. The first version of AutoCAD (1982) ran on a 68030-based computer with an internal Raster Display Adapter (RDA) and graphics hardware. In 1982, the first version of AutoCAD was available as a DOS application. By the late 1980s, it was being sold as a cartridge to be installed in a personal computer. AutoCAD X, the first commercially released version of AutoCAD, was released in 1987 and run on personal computers equipped with an Intel 80286-compatible processor and a high-resolution raster graphics subsystem, for maximum resolution drawing output. AutoCAD R14 was the first release of AutoCAD to require a new 32-bit architecture and a high-resolution graphics subsystem. Its release was preceded by a wave of announcement of the new architecture. In the late 1980s, AutoCAD X was gradually superseded by the new release, and AutoCAD X was only supported by the newly released versions of AutoCAD, for backward compatibility. If your CAD system can import and export the AutoCAD Intergraph Technology Standard format (ITS), then there is a great advantage in being able to work with other companies who have adopted the ITS format. The largest advantage is that you can do things like exchange files with other companies, allowing you to get the job done in an automated manner.
